The existing offer of 15 hours of free childcare for all 3 and 4 year old children still continues. We plan to accommodate the needs of as many parents as possible and it would greatly aid our planning if you could please indicate your preference for September. Your answer will not affect your application as we will be applying our published criteria. Our preference would be (please tick):

- Option 1 - 15 hours **mornings only** between 8.45am and 11.45am *
- Option 2 - 15 hours **afternoons only** between 12.20pm and 3.20pm *
- Option 3 - **30 hours under government scheme**. 8.45am – 11.45am and 12.20pm – 3.20pm *
- * In addition, we would like our child to **attend lunch club @ £5.00** per day
- Option 4 - **All day** 8.45am – 3.20pm (with 15 hours free) @ £28.00 per day.
