Once you have decided upon the schools you would like to apply for, here is some practical

information to help you:

How to Apply to a Kingston School

If your child was born between 1st September 2019 and 31st August 2020 then they will start

school in September 2024. If you live in the Royal Borough of Kingston you apply online through

Kingston's website www.kingston.gov.uk or through www.eadmissions.org.uk. You can apply for up

to 6 schools. The Royal Borough of Kingston Primary Schools Admissions Booklet will tell you

more about each school and their admissions criteria which can be found on the Kingston website.

How to Apply to Christ Church

Do use the full name of the school "Christ Church New Malden C of E Primary School", as there is

another school called Christ Church Primary School in the Royal Borough of Kingston located in

Surbiton. If you are a frequent attender of a Christian church and intend to apply under Church

Criteria (see our Admissions Policy on our website for the definition) you should give the

Supplementary Form to your Church Minister to be completed and signed. It is to be found on the

website under About Us/Admissions, or you could collect one from the school office. This must

be returned by the Minister to Christ New Malden C of E Primary School addressed to the Chair

of Governors.
