The days are coming says The Lord, When I will raise up to David, a righteous branch, a king who will reign wisely and do what is right... Jeremiah 23-5

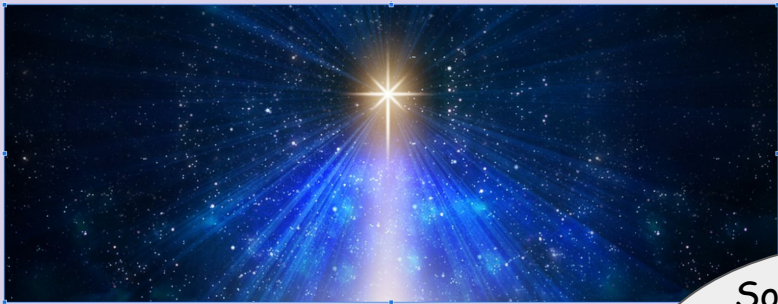

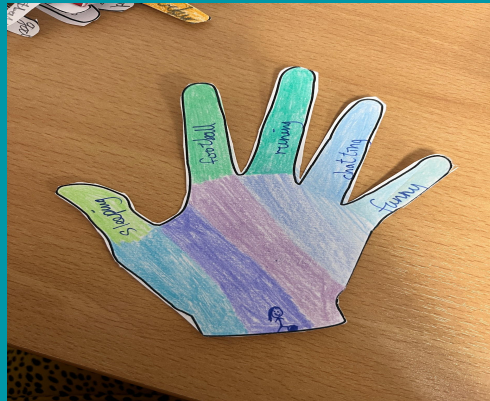
*The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light;

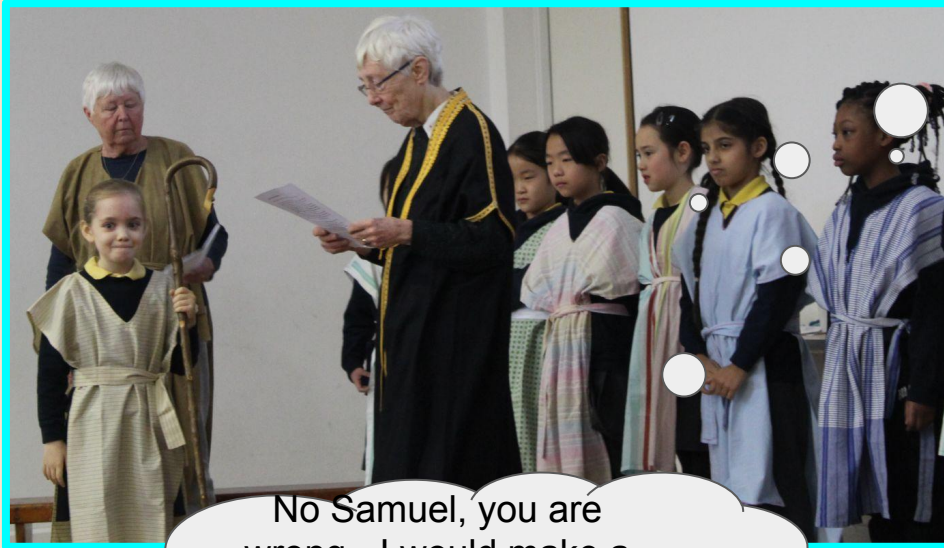
